

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ATHENS-CLARKE COUNTY, GEORGIA WITH RESPECT TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – LICENSE CLASSES AND FEES – WINE MANUFACTURER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

The Commission of Athens-Clarke County, Georgia hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6-3-2, entitled “License--Required; classes; fees,” paragraph (b), entitled “Classes,” of the Code of Athens-Clarke County is hereby amended by adding a new subparagraph (16) thereto as follows:

“(16) Class P, manufacturer of wine only.”

SECTION 2. Section 6-3-2, entitled “License--Required; classes; fees,” paragraph (c), entitled “Fees,” of the Code of Athens-Clarke County is hereby amended by adding a new “Class P” thereto as follows:

“Class P, Manufacturer of wine only . . . 570”

SECTION 3. Section 6-3-5, entitled “General regulations pertaining to all licenses,” paragraph (a), entitled “License not transferable to another location,” of the Code of Athens-Clarke County is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (a) in its entirety and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

“(a) License not transferable to another location. Each license is issued for a specific location only and may not be transferred to another location. A new application is required for each licensed premise. No license, except for a manufacturer license, may be issued to different licensees for the same location.”

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
